Meeting Minutes

COMMITTEE MEMBERS PRESENT: Chairman Rudy Smith, Vice-Chairman Alex Flint, Freddie L. Brantley, and Leo Gaston Jr. were in attendance.

- **1. CALL TO ORDER:** Meeting called to order at 3:00 p.m. by Chairman Rudy Smith.
- II. INVOCATION: Led by Mr. Alex Flint
- III. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Led by Chairman Smith.
- IV. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES: Mr. Leo Gaston made the motion for the approval of the minutes, and Mr. Alex Flint second it.
- **V. PUBLIC COMMENTS:** There were no Public Comments.

VI. OLD BUSINESS:

MR. ANDREW FULGHUM: DRAINAGE STUDY PROPOSAL (MR. NATHANIEL WRIGHT'S PROPERTY) UPDATE:

Mr. Fulghum informed the Transportation Committee that he was advised by the C-Fund Director, that State Procurement Guidelines requires proposals to have more than one (1) quoted bid. Mr. Fulghum will obtain additional bids. The committee accepted the update as information.

MR. MALZONE RUSSELL: REQUEST FOR FUNDING FOR THE RESURFACING OF SECONDARY 341 (FORDVILLE ROAD): Mr. Russell presented a request to the Committee for funding for Secondary 341- Fordville Road in the amount of \$914.452.50. Vice-Chairman Alex flint made a motion to approve funding in the amount of \$914.452.50. for resurfacing Secondary 341 (Fordville Road), and Mr.

Leo Gaston second it. The Committee voted unanimously YES, and the motion was passed and approved.

VI1. NEW BUSINESS:

MR. MALZONE RUSSELL: STATE'S PARTICIPATION IN THE C-FUND

PROGRAM: Mr. Russell presented to the Committee a handout detailing the "Potential Letting Options for SCDOT-Managed CTC Resurfacing Projects." He concisely reviewed the information on the handout with the Committee.

Mr. Russell also requested the committee reapprove the following two (2) projects that was previously approved by the CTC but inadvertently got left out of the approved packet:

- 1. Secondary-223 (Franklin Circle) From 0.00 (s-39 Malphrus Rd.) to End 0.22 (S-222 Lakeview Drive) = 0.22 miles. Est. Cost: \$79,200.00
- 2. Secondary-224 (Lucas Drive) From 0.00 (S-222-Lakeview Drive) to End 0.23 (S-223 Franklin Circle = 0.23 miles. Est. Cost: \$79,200.00

Chairman Smith said they would table reapproval of the projects until the next meeting.

Chairman Smith asked Mr. Fulghum, County Administrator, if he knew what the status was and has a number been received for the Shingler Avenue Project. Mr. Fulghum said he wasn't sure, but he will research it and get back with the committee at the next meeting.
