

# **Project Description**

**Project:** Taxilane Widening and Repairs, Emergency Services Helipad (Design & Construction) (NPE); Airfield Emergency Generator (Design & Construction) (AIG)

Airport: Ridgeland-Claude Dean Airport (3J1)

Geographic Location: Ridgeland-Claude Dean Airport (3J1), Jasper County, Ridgeland,

South Carolina

Objective: Jasper County respectfully requests to use expiring NPE funds to construct taxilane widening within the "Legacy" airfield area as shown on the accompanying sketch. The widening includes the sections included in the 2025 scope of work that the County Council did not accept. The airport has identified additional areas with substandard taxilane widths (14-15' wide) that we propose to widen to a uniform 20' taxilane width. This work is limited to the taxilane width and will generally be on the side opposite of the associated hangars. There are also a couple of isolated existing taxilane pavement repairs that are included. The second element is construction of a helipad for use by emergency services helicopters. The proposed location is near the airfield gate and very close to the County's emergency services building. The helicopters will continue to use the existing flight procedures and will not require a dedicated approach/departure procedure. This project aims to improve safety of the existing taxilanes and providing a dedicated location for emergency services helicopters that use the facility. The airport also proposes to use AIG funds to construct an airfield emergency generator adjacent to the lighting vault that would serve the runway and taxiway systems.





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

**Objective:** Jasper County respectfully requests to use their remaining AIG funds to construct the AIP eligible portion of an extension to Taxiway B and apron to support planned hangars (to be funded by tenants). The work would be limited to pavement that is 50' from each hangar and is common use area. Design of this project is planned for 2026 and will be funded by a SCAC/Local grant. Construction would be accomplished in conjunction with the non-AIP eligible apron and landside road and parking work. The non-AIP portions will be design and bid together with the AIP eligible work as separate bid schedules. The non-AIP work would be funded by a 2027 SCAC grant. This project aims to provide the Airport a development area desirable to potential tenants that will help increase lease revenue and help make the Airport self-sustaining and provide connectivity to up to six (6) new hangar tenants. Construction will be in accordance with FAA requirements and construction specifications.


