Dear Gentlemen:

At the May 15, 2023 Jasper County Council meeting, the Council acted on establishing a temporary moratorium on large Residential Subdivisions, Commercial Development, and signage in certain unincorporated areas of Jasper County. The County Council adopted an ordinance for First Reading, invoking the pending ordinance doctrine.

Enclosed, please find a copy of the Ordinance with an Exhibit depicting the Euhaw River Planning Area.

During the moratorium period, County staff will be working with the County Council, the Jasper County Planning Commission, a Planning Consultant and several other stakeholder groups to study the area with Growth, Development and Conservation. After the study period, the County will update the County Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use Element for this area.

As you will see, the County Council specifically expressed in the ordinance a request of the local municipalities to cooperate with the purpose of the moratorium by not entertaining annexation applications of properties located in the Euhaw Broad River Planning Area.

It is my hope that the Town of Ridgeland and the City of Hardeeville will participate in the County's planning efforts during the temporary moratorium. We will share more information on that process once our consultant is on board. In the meantime, if you have any questions or would like to share your concerns, please feel free to contact me.

Danny Lucas – Consideration of the Ridgeland Claude-Dean Airport Revised Landscape Maintenance Agreement

This Agreement made this 30th day of May, 2023 by and between **Jasper County SC** (hereinafter referred to as "Owner") and Ocean Woods Landscaping Co., Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor").

WHEREAS, Owner wishes to retain the services of the Contractor for the purpose of performing the grounds maintenance of Ridgeland Claude Dean Airport, 1765 Grays Hwy, Ridgeland, SC 29936 as more fully outlined below.

1. TERM

This agreement shall commence on **June 6TH**, **2023** and remain in effect for a period of one (1) year. This agreement shall automatically renew each year unless Client or Contractor provides a thirty (30) day written notice not to renew. Further, Client or Contractor reserves the right to terminate this agreement with <u>thirty (30) days written notice</u> at any time for any reason whatsoever. Contractor reserves the right to cancel service for non-payment without notice.

SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED

Weekly landscape maintenance to include mowing, edging, pruning, litter and debris pickup, fertilization, and curative herbicide and pesticide applications as more fully described below.

A. LAWN CARE

- (i) <u>Mowing:</u> Grass will be mowed once weekly to maintain a neat appearance (minimum of once weekly during growing season).
- (ii) <u>Edging</u>: Mechanical edging around plant beds and walks as desirable to maintain a neat appearance.

B. CLEAN -UP OF LITTER

(i) <u>Walkways, Patios, Decks and Driveways</u>: Will be vacuumed, swept, or blown clean, not less than twice monthly. Landscape debris and trash will be removed from all areas as required to insure neat appearance.

C. FERTILIZATION PROGRAM

(i) <u>Grass:</u> All turf will be fertilized two times per year with a complete analysis fertilizer at the appropriate rate.

D. CHEMICAL SPRAY PROGRAM

(i) Grass: Apply post-emergent herbicides for the control of broadleaf weeds.

Establish a **curative*** spray program to treat damage from insects and fungal disease. Applications will be made up to once monthly in response to observed damage from insects or fungal disease.

*Fungicide and pre-emergent are available upon request for additional costs

E. WEEDING

- (i) <u>Beds</u>: Will be maintained weed-free and trash-free mechanically or by chemical control.
- (ii) Grass and Weeds Growing through Pavement: Will be removed mechanically or by chemical control.

SERVICE AREA

Area, including ditches, along the edges of Taxiway "B"

Area on the southside of Taxiway "B" to include areas around all hangars eastward to the perimeter fence.

Area to include Terminal grounds (electric gates to Grays Highway)

Ditches (Airport Road - Wrong Road) - Trash Pick-Up on Wrong Road

Westside only (Grays Highway)

4. INCLEMENT WEATHER CONDITIONS

Contractor will not be responsible for damage caused by major flooding or for removal of large trees and debris as a result of unusually high winds or water. <u>Any work performed and/or extra debris disposal charges incurred due to extraordinary circumstances, such as hurricanes, tropical storms, tornados, exceptionally high wind, or freezes, will be charged back to the Owner at applicable rates. Officials Present: Chairman L. Martin Sauls IV, Vice Chairwoman Barbara B. Clark (via ZOOM) Councilman Pastor Alvin Adkins, Councilman John Kemp and Councilman Coy Garbade.

Staff Present: County Administrator Andrew Fulghum, Clerk to Council Wanda H. Simmons, County Attorney David Tedder, Kimberly Burgess, Russell Wells, Danny Lucas, Rose Dobson-Elliott, Lisa Wagner, and Videographer Jonathan Dunham.

Chairman Sauls called the meeting to order at 9:00AM and welcomed everyone to the Retreat. The Report of Compliance with the Freedom of Information Act was given, the Pledge to the Flag was recited and the invocation was given. Chairman Sauls and Mr. Fulghum gave the opening remarks for the retreat.

A presentation with discussion of the Annual Comprehensive Financial Report (FY Ended June 30, 2022) was given by the Baird Audit Group, LLC.

Ms. Burgess reviewed the ARPA Funding and Expenditures with Council and Mr. Fulghum discussed and gave updates to Council on the Transportation Sales Tax Program. A discussion of upcoming workshops dates for topics of Exit 3, the Airport, Bailey Park PDD and the Gillisonville Sand Mine were considered. A presentation and discussion of the Capital Improvement and Investments Plan was provided by M.B. Kahn Construction. There was also a discussion and request for Policy Direction for the FY23-24 Budget and Budget Schedule (including American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funds and Financial Policies was requested. The State and Federal funding requests was discussed. The County-wide Impact Fee Study and the Opioid Settlement Funds were reviewed.

Emergency service issues including the Levy Volunteer Fire Department (LVFD) Transition, Jasper County and the Hardeeville Ambulance Service, Litter Enforcement and Code Enforcement were reviewed and discussed and a report on our Litter Control Program was given. Tax Collection Agreements with Municipalities, Solid Waste, Recycling, and Roads & Bridges and Motor Grader Road Schedule and Operators were also reviewed. The County Owned and/or County Maintained Roads within Municipal Boundaries were discussed as well as the Broad River Area Planning Efforts / Conservation Efforts / Partnerships.

There was a discussion of ongoing Human Resource Issues relating to the number of open positions, current recruiting methods and marketing initiatives for recruitment was reviewed and discussed. The handling of PPD's was also reviewed. Council had listed an Executive Session for this retreat but
